Call to Order

Agency Updates

Peggy Pelton (MHDR/Community Services) noted that the MHDD system is under the jurisdiction of the state and no longer local therefore there may be some changes in the next couple of months.

Petlon pointed out NAMI-Dubuque opened a Peer-Run Wellness Center at 601 Grant Street. The center is open Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Discussion followed regarding the RTA providing services for the Peer Run Wellness Center. Kuhle indicated that in the next few weeks staff would meet with NAMI and explore ways to provide service for their clients. It was also discussed how to provide service for the Second Helpings Monday evening free dinners. Kuhle indicated that they may have found a volunteer driver but first would like to attend a dinner and hand out flyers to see what their needs may be. Helmrich indicated that she would let Kuhle know when the next meal would be.

Passenger Transportation Plan (PTP)

Dan Fox gave a brief update of the PTP and the involvement of the Delaware Tag Committee. He explained the PTP is a document required by the Iowa DOT and identifies priorities and strategies to meet identified needs in the region that can lead to projects. The Tag committee will be consulted in the development and review of the plan. The goal of the plan is to improve transportation service, increase passenger awareness and coordination, develop new working partnerships and future passenger transportation investments. The Draft PTP plan will be due February 1, 2025, with a final plan due May 1, 2025. Jack Studier, who followed up the discussion by presenting the survey RTA staff will be distributing to all TAG members asking for members' input to identify new objectives and strategies for the future. Fox explained that the results of the survey will be presented at the work session at the All-County Tag meeting on December 4, 2024.

Discussion followed.

Grant Updates

Kuhle said the RTA was notified in May that they were awarded the United Way to continue the Ride to Wellness program. Studier explained that the RTA was not awarded any funding from their application to Community Foundation, DRA, McDonough Foundation and Cottingham and Bulter grants.
